FOR TOMORROW'S PALEONTOLOGISTS:

Kids will have a field day exploring the American Museum of Natural History's fossil halls, which now house a cast of a **titano-saur**, a recently discovered, 122-foot-long dinosaur. An in-house curator at the 238-room **St. Regis New York** creates customized two-hour family tours of the Upper West Side institution or other city museums, which include art sessions, interactive quizzes (with prizes!), and, once back at the St. Regis, an in-depth look at the hotel's Old King Cole mural. *Doubles from \$995; Virtuoso travelers receive breakfast daily and a \$100 dining credit.
